WALTER MARSHALL Lived in the 1600s (Presbyterian)

Marshall writes, "Be sure to seek for holiness of heart and life only in its due order, where God hath placed it -- after union with Christ, justification, and the gift of the Holy Ghost; and in that order seek it earnestly, by faith, as a very necessary part of your salvation."
