WHAT A REVELATION By J. Clyde Flewelling

Psalms 9:17 "The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God."

What a picture we catch as we look ahead and see in God's Word what Hell is like and then consider all that go there. Not much is said these days about the abode of the wicked, but if you forget God and go to Hell you will take with you a consciousness of being lost. There is no more horrible feeling; it is the dreadful sense that possesses men and women on a sinking vessel or out on a bleak desert. The brain reels under it, and reason is soon dethroned. The human mind cannot long endure the sense of being lost. May God hasten us to the Blood before it is too late.
